

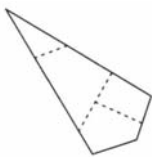
Crazy Quilt Star

Cutting

1. From muslin or white cotton fabric, cut 4 corner points A and 4 half point sections C as foundation for crazy quilting.
2. Reverse half star section C template and cut 4 from gold print.
3. Cut 4 each B and BR triangles from dark blue print.

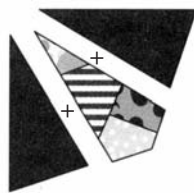
Directions

1. Draw random sections on muslin corner points and star sections as guides for crazy-quilt patches. Do not use dark blue print on star. If desired, use gold print on outer points of piece A. Cut a piece of print fabric to cover one section of a foundation piece adding about 3/16" seam allowance to edges. Pin to the muslin foundation.

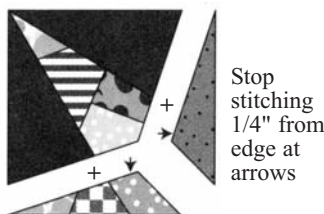


2. Cut another piece from a different fabric to cover the adjacent section. Place this piece wrong side up along edge of first piece. Stitch using a 3/16" seam allowance. Fold piece over second section. Continue in this manner until piece is covered with print fabrics. Complete all crazy quilt sections in this manner.

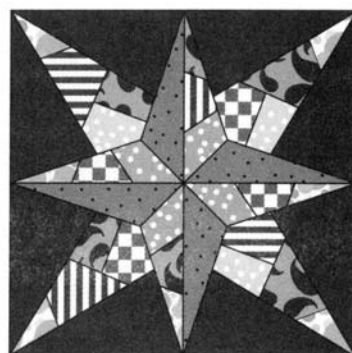
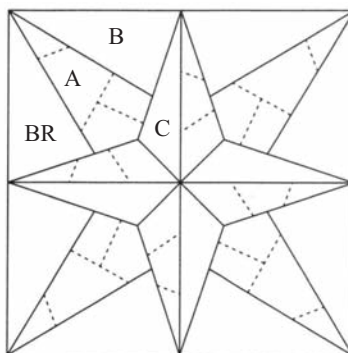
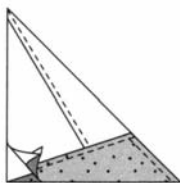
3. Stitch dark blue triangles B and BR to long sides of each corner point A.



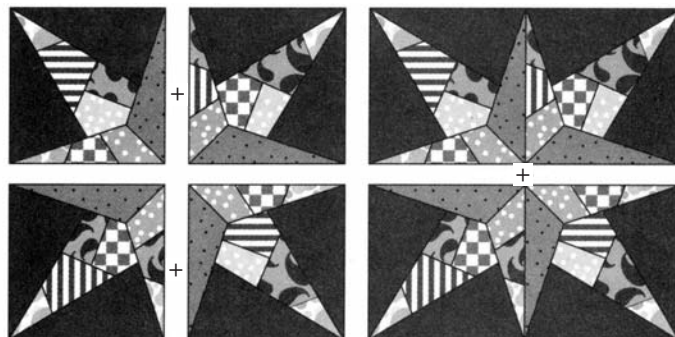
4. Stitch a crazy quilt half point C to one edge of A-B unit ending stitching 1/4" from edge at seam line on inner edge. Stitch a gold print half point C to remaining edge, ending stitching 1/4" from end at seam line on inner edge.



5. Stitch edges of half points together to make a square. Repeat to make 3 more squares.

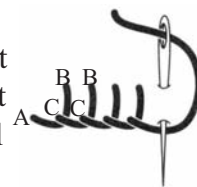


6. Arrange squares to make a star. Stitch squares together in pairs. Then stitch pairs together to complete block.



7. Using 3 strands of different color embroidery floss, embroider along outer edges of star and seams of patchwork. Use chevron stitch, feather stitch, blanket stitch, or any other stitch you like.

Blanket Stitch: Bring needle up at point 'A', down at point 'B', up again at point 'C'. Repeat down at 'B', up at 'C' until complete.



Feather Stitch: Bring needle up at point 'A', down at point 'B', up again at point 'C', down at 'D', up at 'E', down at 'F'. Repeat until complete.

Chevron Stitch: Bring needle up at point 'A', down at point 'B', up again at point 'C' (keeping thread underneath stitch A-B). Insert needle down at 'D', up at 'E', and down at 'F'. Bring needle up again at 'G', keeping stitch E-F on top of points D and G. Insert needle down at 'H'. Repeat A-H until stitching is complete.
