

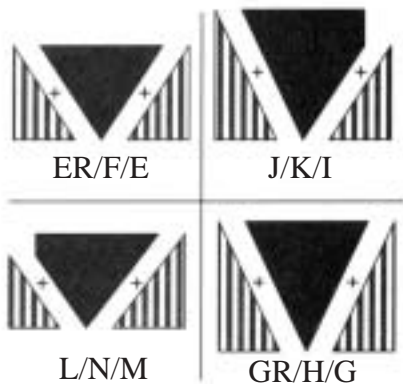
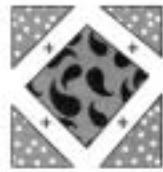
Uneven Star

Cutting

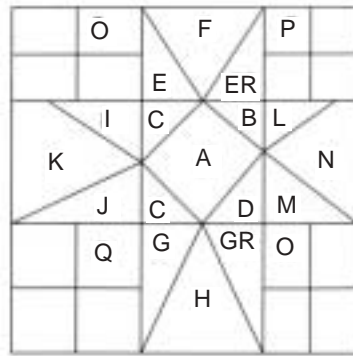
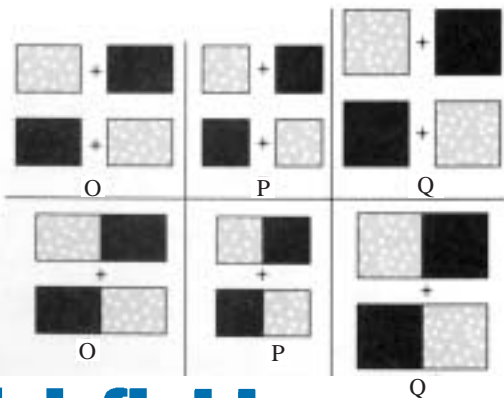
1. Cut diamond A from paisley.
2. Cut triangle B, triangle D, and 2 triangles C from yellow/white print.
3. From blue/yellow stripe, cut star points, E, ER, G and GR. Cut one each of star points I, J, L, and M.
4. From dark blue print, cut F, K, H and N. Cut four pieces from O, and two pieces each from P and Q.
5. From light blue print, cut four pieces from O, and two pieces each from P and Q.

Directions

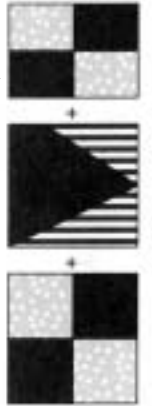
1. Following piecing diagrams, stitch B, C and D triangles to correct edges of paisley diamond.
2. Stitch star points E and ER to F, star points G and GR to H, star points I and J to K and star points L and M to N.



3. Stitch each light blue rectangle O to a dark blue rectangle. Stitch pairs together to form a 4 patch square so that colors alternate. Join remaining pieces O, P and Q in the same manner.



4. Arrange the pieced units following the diagram. Stitch O unit to top of I-K unit. Stitch Q unit to lower edge of this piece.



5. Stitch E-F unit to top of A-D unit. Stitch G-H unit to lower edge of A-D unit.



6. Stitch P unit to top of L-N unit. Stitch remaining O unit to lower edge of this piece.



7. Stitch these sections together matching seams to form star block.
