

Burgundy Pillow with Center Panel and Fringe

Materials:

1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards burgundy fabric
13" wide X 15" long
contrast fabric for center panel
2 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards fringe
26" piece cord to make trim
Zipper Foot
14" x 28" Soft Touch Pillow Insert

Instructions

(Measurements include $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam Allowances)

To make cording for each side of center panel, cut a bias strip of burgundy fabric 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26", Sandwich the cord inside of wrong side of bias strip, sew closed with zipper foot.

Cut one piece of burgundy fabric for back, 29" wide x 15" long.
Cut 2 pieces of burgundy fabric for front 9" wide x 15" long
Cut center contrasting fabric 13" wide x 15" long.

Sew cording to each side of center panel, sew 9" x 15" pieces to each side of center panel with right sides facing.

Sew fringe to right side of front panel, lay fringe to inside facing center and sew all around using a zipper foot.

Pin back to front with right sides facing, sew sections together with the front section on top and sew along the stitching line from the fringe.

Leave a 10" opening on one long edge, turn right side out, and insert pillow form and slipstitch closed.
