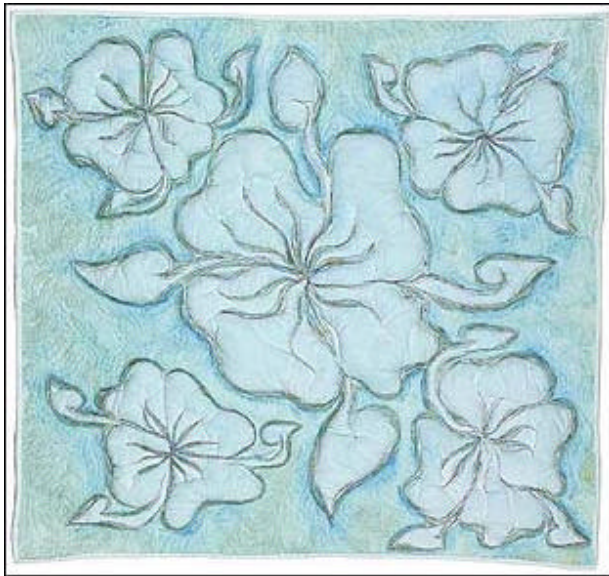


# Jumbo Pansy



## Materials Needed:

-----  
Softtouch batting( white or off-white White fabric/ white cotton back )  
8oz poly  
36 inches square of cotton fabric for front  
Back should be 39 inches square.  
Blue marking pen( rinses away with water)  
Gouda ( clear)  
superior metallic, rainbow  
Water soluble thread  
Signature cotton , Ice blue  
Seta color paint ( green, blue)  
Paint brush any

## Directions:

-----  
Fold fabric and find center. Mark with pin  
Use a blue marking pen. ( rinses away with cold water)  
( do not heat set)  
Draw Jumbo Pansies on cloth.  
Take 80z white poly batting and lay underneath the top with drawn image. You are ready for sew basting  
Baste with water soluble thread . sew over the blue lines.  
Take off machine  
Cut away all the negative areas around the sewing lines. ( around flowers)  
Relayer the quilt with soft touch cotton batting  
You are now ready to quilt. At this point you can pin baste or hand baste your quilt.  
quilt around the flowers .  
blue on top.  
Shade around the flowers with white thread and a spiral motion your shading size will be the size of a pencil eraser in a continuous motion  
Quilt the remaining negative areas of your quilt with your favorite filler design. Quilt closely  
Paint when you are done.  
Use gouda ( clear) from Dharma Trading) helps prevent colors from bleeding into each other. use on shaded areas.  
Next paint and play  
finally turn over your quilt for scribble filling.  
The final stage of shading. Use the metallic in your bobbin. and signature cotton in top.  
**Have fun!!!!**

\*Remember to rinse away your blue marker thoroughly in cold water before Rinsing your basting thread with hot water.
