

Tooth Fairy Pillow



Basic Sewing Supplies

Soft Touch® 10" x 10" pillow form
Scissors, straight pins, ruler, thread to match project

Optional: rotary cutter, mat, acrylic ruler, fabric glue, hot glue gun, and glue sticks.

All seam allowances are 1/4"

Pillows have a lapped back closure.

Materials:

1/2 yd. background fabric
4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square yellow fabric
4" x 8" piece white cotton fabric
12" 3/8" wide satin ribbon
Permanent fabric pen
1/2 yard Tear Away Stabilizer

Instructions

- 1.) From background fabric, cut one 13" x 13" square for pillow top.
- 2.) Using provided pattern, cut out two teeth from white fabric. With right sides together, sew around all sides leaving a small opening for turning. Clip curves. Turn. Press. Satin stitch across the TOP of the tooth and satin stitch the detail line.
- 3.) Machine appliqué the yellow square to the center of the 13" x 13" square. From the back carefully trim away the excess background fabric behind the appliqué.
- 4.) Leaving a 1" margin at the top, appliqué the tooth to the yellow square. Leave 2 1/2" open at the top for the tooth pocket.
- 5.) Using the permanent pen, trace "Sweet Dreams" across the top of the yellow square. Heat set the printing with an iron.
- 6.) From the remaining background fabric, cut two pieces 13" x 9". Hem one long side on each piece.
- 7.) Layer right sides together on top of the pillow top to match the size of the pillow top. Hemmed edges should be to the center of the pillow. Stitch all four sides. Clip the corners, Turn to the right side. Press.
- 8.) Topstitch all four sides 1 1/4" in from the edges to create the flange. Insert the pillow form.
- 9.) Tie the ribbon into a bow and sew to corner of the yellow square as shown in the photo.
